<u>Part – A :-</u>

The plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement and outcome achieved by the end of the year is as follows :

After getting the guideline for the formation of IQAC, we immediately formed the IQAC. The IQAC chalked out plan in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement. The IQAC took into account the suggestions made by Peer – Team and decided to achieve excellence. The committee, as suggested by the Peer – Team, decided to seek grant from U.G.C. for Boys and Girls hostel. The committee also decided to carry out some excellent activities for the students which can prepare them for competitive exams and civil services. To encourage the students for their own business, the IQAC decided to arrange visits of industries and other business houses. The IQAC emphasized on providing internet facilities to the students during the library hours. Besides, the IQAC planned to execute regular activities conducted by our college with more vigour and excellence. The IQAC decided to start self finance courses on the campus. The IQAC, to encourage the faculty members for research work, decided to inspire them to attend national and international seminars and present papers. It also instructed the Ph.D. degree holders to go for guide ship and research activities.

<u>Part – B :-</u> <u>1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution :</u>

Arts and Commerce College, Himatnagar has conducted various activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution. The chief goal of our institution is to inculcate discipline, determination and love for modern and quality education. The institution takes great care for discipline among students. All the students have to produce their identity cards whenever asked. The students are strictly warned not to move in the premises without an identity card. The teachers and discipline committee randomly check the students. And if a student is found without an identity card, is fined for the first time and warned to keep it always with him / her.

In the beginning of the year, the teachers, the administrative staff and the senior students under the guidance of the principal, arrange a programme for welcoming the new entrants of the college. They provide enough information of the college rules and regulations of our college and the regular activities, we carry out during the year. The toppers of various classes are introduced to the new comers, so that they might be encouraged for it. The college also plans and implements the various activities keeping in mind the goals and objectives of the institution. During the year, we give them various programmes which inculcate discipline among the students. The 'Adhit Committee' and various lectures organized by various departments encourage the students for intellectual development. The college also encourages the students to join N.C.C., N.S.S. and other activities. Sothat every facet of students' personality can be encouraged.

We also focus on the activities which provide job after completion of graduation or post graduation to the students. During the year 2007-08, many of our students sought job in private sectors such as ceramic units, ICICI bank, Kotak Mahindra bank and H.D.F.C. bank. These banks have requested us to send some bright students for an interview. First, we circulated the information to the students and sent our students for interviews. At present, many of our students have got job in such private banks and companies.

Himatnagar is the district place of Sabarkantha. In the district, there are many colleges, most of the colleges have undergone NAAC process. We are proud to mention that our college has got maximum marks in the district.

2. New Academic programmes initiated (UG and PG) :

Our college is affiliated to the H.N.G. Univ., Patan. We do not have autonomy in designing curriculum. However, some of our teachers are members of Academic Councils, Board of Studies and Senate. The university invites them for the discussion on curriculum design. The members of such committees first arrange meeting in the college with the colleagues and get feed back which they put forward in academic council or Board of studies. In this way, our faculties render services in designing of curricula.

During the year 2007-08, a new paper has been introduced for Post – Graduate students. – Following the U.G.C. guideline for curriculum the department of Economics sent a proposal for a new optional paper for Post Graduation Part – I and Part – II. The university considered the proposal and allowed us a new optional paper in Part – I (Paper – 4) and in Part – II (Paper – 8). The title of the paper is 'Information Technology and Data Analysis'. The students of Economics may have bright scope after studying this paper. These papers may be helpful to them for further research and data analysis.

We have started self finance P.G. Course in English Literature.

3. Innovation in curricular design and transaction :

All the colleges affiliated to H.N.G. Univ., Patan has to follow the syllabi of the university strictly. We do not have any power to initiate new programmes. However, we suggest some new books and topics to the members of AC and Board of Studies and Senate. The members forward our suggestion and in this way we play a little role in curricular design. Our teachers attend workshops and other programmes for curricular design and help the Board of Studies in designing curricula.

We send our teachers in various academic workshop, conferences and seminars. In this way, our teachers come in contact with the teachers of other universities. They interact with the teachers of other universities and get information about their curricula. Our teachers forward this information in a meeting to the members of Board of Studies and thereby help updating the curricula.

During the year 2007-08, the faculty members of our Department of Economics got a new paper included into the syllabus. Ours is the only college which offer this new paper entitled "Information Technology and Data Analysis".

<u>4. Interdisciplinary programmes started :</u>

As we do not have autonomy in initiating programmes, we do not have full fledged inter disciplinary programmes. However, we have some papers at under graduate and Post graduate level which can be considered as inter disciplinary. For example, the students of Department of English study few books of Sanskrit literature and Persian literature. Likewise, the students of Economics study Computer Science as a subject at U.G. level, we also offer Computer Science as a subsidiary subject to the students of Commerce, which help them in getting job after graduation.

At P.G. level also, we have books of Sanskrit literature for the students of English.

5. Examination reforms implemeted :

We follow the university guide line for examination. We regularly arrange two tests and an extra test for the absent students. Besides, we also arrange class tests, assignment work and subject wise tests. Our practice keep the students alert for university exam and they face the university exam with full confidence.

We have a committee which takes care of college exams and Univ. exam. We inform the students in the beginning of the year and prepare them for better results in both the exams. During the year 2007-08, we have computerized system in exam committee. We arrange the students during exam in such a way that they can freely and fearlessly face the exam. We stick all the rules on the main notice board, notice board on the first floor and second floor. We also stick computerized sheets on the door of each exam hall. Our practice is well appreciated by the students and other stake holders. We stick separate piece of paper on each bench mentioning the role number of every student. The students find it comfortable and convenient. After the second test, we arrange an extra test for the absentees. We have a computerized form for making request for the extra test. We charge Rupees 100 per paper for extra test. However, if a student is engaged in any of our college activity or university activity, we charge nothing from him / her. We provide a computerized receipt for the same. We also collect the papers of other colleges and make the students solve the papers in the class room. If they have any difficulty concerned teacher help them in solving the questions.

We invite some good resource persons who guide our student how to face competitive exams.

18. Community Services :

Our college promotes community services through N.S.S. and N.C.C. units and other activities conducted by college or various committees of the college. We have two units of N.S.S. One hundred twenty five boys and twenty nine girls have been enrolled as volunteers. We arrange a ten days camp generally at rural places. The volunteers under the care of two programme officers stay at a camp site for ten days and undertake various activities like rally for AIDS awareness, free addiction society, cleanliness, anti tobacco campaign etc. The volunteers arrange cultural programmes during their stay and thereby aware the people. They encourage the villagers for women education and female foeticide. Our college, with the help of N.S.S. and N.C.C. volunteers, arranges blood donation camp in collaboration with Prathna Blood Centre, Ahmedabad. Nearly one hundred and four bottles of blood have been collected. The N.S.S. and N.C.C. unit also help during the Thelesemia camp. Yoga committee of our college has conducted ten days training camp for the senior citizen of Himatnagar town. More than 80 senior citizens have participated in the Yoga camp. Mr. A.J. Trivedi rendered his services as a Yoga teacher to them. The college provides its ground to the various communities for arranging mass marriages.

<u>19. Teachers and officers newly recruited :</u>

The following staff has been appointed by the management during the year 2007-08. Mr. S.B. Patel has been appointed as a visiting teacher in the department of Psychology and Mr. Dewda in the department of Physical Education.

The management has also appointed four persons in administrative staff. They are – Mr. J.G. Sisodiya for office work, Miss. P.R. Patel as Computer Operator and Mr. K.B. Prajapati and Mr. Laxminarayan Pandit as Peons.

21. Improvements in Library services :

Our library is a large and airy. It is located at the extreme end of the building. The students are informed about the library services through notices on the main library notice board and circulating it in the class rooms. Last year, we started computerization of library and we have made almost 70% entries of the books available in the library. The library committee regularly arranges meetings with the library staff gets suggestions from the students and try to provide utmost facilities to the students. The library committee allocate fund as required various departments. The heads of various by departments consult the library committee and put their demands before it. The committee takes care of the demands of various departments and help in purchasing new books and journals. Just beside the library, we have a spacious reading room for the students which can accommodate approximately 100 readers at a time. In the same reading room, we have a room where a computer with internet facility has been placed students are free to access it during the college library hours.

We provide a set of books to the students who become a member of poor boys library. The first class holders of each class are given books free of charge and the rest are offered on a meager amount. The physically handicapped students are given sets by sending a peon in a class room. The teachers whenever visit any book fair or book store, are free to purchase books worth buying. Such books are included in the library later on by paying the amount to the concerned teacher.

22. New books / journals subscribed and their cost :

During the year 2007-08, 818 books are purchased for college General library. Its cost is Rs. 90780/-. One hundred fifty five (155) books costing Rs. 17233/- are purchased for poor boys library. Under the U.G.C. book bank head 562 books are purchased worth rupees 63118. Total number of 57 journals and periodicals are subscribed, the subscription of which amounts to rupees 19573. For P.G. students our library has purchased 523 books worth rupees 63581. We also subscribe dailies both in vernacular and English language. During this year Rs. 2,54,285 has been spent for the purchase of various books and subscription of various journals.

23. Courses in which student assessment of teacher is introduced and the action taken on student feed back :

During 2007-08, we do not have circulated feedback forms to the students but we encourage students to submit their suggestions in the suggestion box. The principal and the committee members regularly check the suggestions and take care to resolve them. The students are free to approach the principal and the heads of various departments. They take into account their demands and suggestions and try to solve them amicably.

25. Computerization of administration and the process of admission and examination results, issue of certificates :

In our college most of the administrative work is executed through computers. The process of admission is fully computerized. The students are given computerized fee - receipts. Our computer teachers have prepared software to collect the fees. He has also prepared software which bifurcate male – female students, ST, SC, OBC and General category of the students. Every month our clerk prepares computerized salary statement and at the end of the year a consolidated statement is given to every teacher. The exam committee has its own computer and everything is executed with the help of computers. The students who come for recommendation letter for studies in abroad are given computerized recommendation letters. The administrative staff helps such students in preparing their transcripts. The results of both the regular test and extra test are displayed on notice board in computerized sheets. The forms for extra test and its fee receipts are also provided in computerized form.

26. Increase in infrastructural facilities :

Our college has received grant for the construction of new additional class rooms under the 10^{th} plan. We have built three new class rooms on the second floor of

our college building. The Government of Gujarat has sanctioned a computer aided language laboratory to our college. We have provided a spacious room on ground floor for it. The government released 2.5 lakh rupees for infrastructure within the room. Later on the government agency came to install 25 computers, 25 head phones and 25 web cameras. We have constructed 24 booths for the learners and a well equipped table for a teacher. All twenty four computers are LAN connected with the server. Mr. P.M. Joshi, department of English is appointed a co-ordinator of Language Laboratory.

28. Computer and internet access and training to teachers and students :

Our college offers computer science as one of the subjects to the students of commerce. Students who offer this subject are well trained by the teacher. The other students make use of the computer in the library. In case of difficulty the teachers and the administrative staff help them to overcome difficulties. We have also a centre of BAOU. We encourage the students to join the courses conducted by BAOU. We have a separate computer lab for the students of BAOU. Most of the students go there and under guidance of centre in - charge make optimal use of computers. The members of the administrative staff and the teaching staff join BAOU for computer knowledge and some of teachers and members of administrative staff have successfully completed CCC exam.

Dr. K.S. Bhatt and Mr. P.M. Joshi under went a ten days training course at H.M. Patel Institute V.V. Nagar. The main objective of the training is to prepare the teachers for computer aided lang. laboratory.

29. Financial aid to students :

We have a separate free ship committee which invites application from the poor students for financial aid. The committee scrutinizes the application and offer free ship to the needy students. During the year 2007-08, we have provided free-ship to 41 students of various classes. The total amount of free-ship is Rs. 32822.

30. Support from the alumni association and its activities :

During the 2007-08, the alumni association in collaboration with Star batch committee arranged a programme to felicitate the first class holders in various university exams on 24th Jan., 2008. In P.G. library hall the office bearers of alumni association congratulated the students and encouraged for better performance in future. Mr. Satish Patel, Joint Co-ordinator of SPIPA delivered a lecture on Career Guidance and encouraged the students for entrance exam for M.B.A., M.C.A. and other higher courses. Mr. V.M. Dedun, District Employment Officer, Himatnagar also delivered an informative lecture on opportunities for employment.

31. Support from the parent – teacher association and its

activities :

The parents – teacher association, in collaboration with college cultural committee arranged a musical programme entitled 'College – Idol'. More than 50 students enrolled for this 'Singing Competition' - out of which 20 students are given training of singing with musical band. It was divided into two rounds. In first round, each participant sang a Hindi filmy song and in the second round regional song. At the end of the programme Mr. Amit Patel, Miss. Amita Patil and Mr. Ganpat Mangela were declared as winners. Programme was attended by all the stakeholders.

32. Health service :

We have already established a health centre in or college premises. Dr. Bharat Shah (M.B.B.S.) visits our college for an hour thrice a week. The students, sport persons and teaching and administrative staff take advantage of this facility. In case of emergency, we take our students to the reputed doctors. Fortunately, our president, Dr. Chimanbhai Patel and Joint Director Dr. K.K. Patel are reputed medical practicenors of the town. They provide us excellent services in case of emergency.

We have arranged Thallesemia testing for the students of F.Y.B.A. and F.Y.B.Com. The senior students have already undergone this testing the previous year. It was arranged on 8th Jan., 2008 in collaboration with Red Cross Society, Ahmedabad. The N.C.C. cadets and N.S.S. volunteers extended their services during the camp. After receiving reports of the students we have

circulated them personally.

We have arranged a blood donation camp in collaboration with Prathana Blood Centre, Ahmedabad and collected 104 bottles of blood.

The Yoga and Health committee has arranged a camp for the students of our college for 30 days. More than 50 students attended the programme and benefited out of it. Mr. A.J. Trivedi, Department of English, and 'Yoga guru' extended his services free off charge.

33. Performance in sports activities :

During the year 2007-08, 115 students participated in various sports events out of which 9 students participated in Inter University sports event and 6 students at National Level.

In basket-ball, our college became Champion. 5 students of our college were selected in Inter University competition and represented our university in All India Basket-ball Competition held in Kerala.

Mr. Harshvardhansinh Puwar participated in 100 meter and 200 meter sprint and declared the best athlete by the university. 7 students of our college represented our institution in Inter University and 6 students at All India Level.

34. Incentive to outstanding sports persons :

Every year, we arrange College Annual Day in the month of January or in the beginning of February. We appreciated the entire sports person during the programme. We distribute various prizes to the sports persons in the form of Trophies. We offer free-ship to the sport persons of the winning team. We facilitate them with track shoes and blazers on the Annual Day function. Mr. Swapnil Thakor, a captain of College Basket-ball team represented our university at All India Basket-ball Competition. Considering his outstanding performance he has been selected as a senate member by vice chancellor of the university.

35. Students achievements and awards :

- Mr. Swapnil Thakor, an outstanding performer in basket-ball has been selected as a senate member.
- Mr. Kurshi Desai has been selected for R.D.C. Camp and participated in a parade at New Delhi.
- Miss. Megha Joshi, a student of T.Y.B.Com. stood fourth in the university exam. She got 70 out of 70 marks in the subject of statistics.

<u>36. Activities of the guidance and counselling unit :</u>

During the year 2007-08, our college has arranged employment training camp in collaboration with District Udhyog Centre, Himatnagar. The General Manager of this centre provided information to the students. Every student was given a book containing information about various employment opportunities. Mr. Satish Patel, Joint – Director of SPIPA provided guidance to the students for competitive exams and encouraged the students for administrative officers.

We have a separate counseling centre Ms. A.M. Dholakiya is the convener of it. She provides counseling to the students as and when required.

<u>37. Placement services provided to the students :</u>

We invite the guest to guide our students for various opportunities in professional fields. Himatnagar is a town having so many cera industries. These industries inform our college authorities through a letter or an advertisement. We display such information on general notice board and encourage the students. The private banks viz. - ICICI, Kotak Mahindra and H.D.F.C. have arranged interviews in the town. We this information circulated to the students and encouraged them for the interview. Many of our students have been selected in private banks.

38. Development programmes for non-teaching staff :


