GM subsidiary Cruise's Co-founder & CEO Kyle Vogt quits

San Francisco, Nov 20 (IANS) Kyle Vogt, co-founder and CEO of GM's self-driving car subsidiary Cruise, has resigned, in less than a month after the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) suspended Cruise's deployment and driverless testing permits.

GM Chair and CEO Mary Barra announced that Mo Elshenawy, executive vice president of engineering at Cruise, will serve as president and CTO for Cruise, reports TechCrunch.

However, the new Cruise CEO was yet to be announced.

"Cruise is still just getting started, and I believe it has a great future ahead. You all are brilliant, driven and resilient. I'm deeply saddened I won't be working next to you anymore," Vogt told employees in an email.

"However, I know you're executing against a very strong, multi-year technology roadmap and exciting product vision, and I'm thrilled to see what

Cruise has in store in its next chapter," he added.

He also posted on X: "As for what's next for me, I plan to spend time with my family and explore some new ideas. Thanks for the great ride!" Barra said that the Cruise Board understands and respects his decision to resign as CEO. "We wish him well in his next chapter. We continue to believe strongly in Cruise's mission and the potential of its transformative technology as we look to make transportation safer, cleaner and more accessible," Barra added.

On October 2, a pedestrian, initially hit by a human-driven car and landed in the path of a Cruise robotaxi, ran over and dragged 20 feet by the autonomous vehicle. A video showed the robotaxi braking aggressively and coming to a stop over the woman. The DMV order stopped Cruise's robotaxi operations in San Francisco just months after receiving the last necessary permit to commercialise its operations.

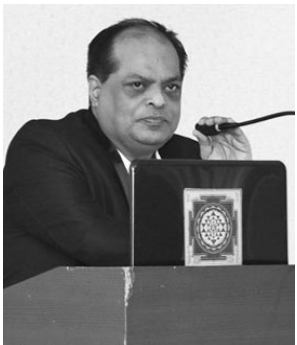
New Delhi : In the realm of governance and public service, politics is a domain that typically demands more than mere rhetoric or superficial engagement.

Social media giants 'big, bad monsters': US Families suing Big Tech

San Francisco/London, Nov 20 (IANS) Hundreds of families are suing social media giants like TikTok, Snapchat, YouTube and



Meta (parent company of Instagram and Facebook) in the US and they feel the tech companies as "big, bad monsters". According to the BBC, the plaintiffs include ordinary families and school districts from across the US. "I literally

was trapped by addiction at age 12. And I did not get my life back for all of my teenage years," Taylor Little, now 21, was quoted as saying in the report that came out on Monday. Taylor's social media addiction led to suicide attempts and years of depression. "If I had my phone taken away, it felt like having withdrawals. It was unbearable. Literally, when I say it was addictive, I don't mean it was habit-

forming. I mean, my body and mind craved that," she was quoted as saying. Taylor also struggled with content around body image and eating disorders. Taylor and hundreds of other American families are suing four of the biggest tech companies -- Meta (parent company of Facebook and Instagram), TikTok, Google and Snap Inc (parent of Snapchat).

Business Brief III

Talks between Sam Altman, OpenAI in final stage for his return as CEO

San Francisco, Nov 20 (IANS) The suspense over Sam Altman's return as the CEO of OpenAI continued on Monday as OpenAI leaders and investors sought to reinstate Altman at the company which unceremoniously sacked him on November 17.

The final negotiations were still on between Altman and the company, with one big condition that the existing board (who fired him) had to step down, reports The Verge.

Altman had once again set a 5 p.m. PT (6.30 a.m. India time) deadline on Sunday for the OpenAI board to resolve the situation.

Microsoft Chairman and CEO Satya Nadella was reportedly mediating the discussion between Altman, former OpenAI President Greg Brockman, and the current board members as they attempt to select a new board. "If a deal isn't reached, things will take a different path," the report mentioned. OpenAI's current board consists of chief scientist Ilya Sutskever, Quora CEO Adam D'Angelo, former GeoSim Systems CEO Tasha McCauley, and Helen Toner, the director of strategy at Georgetown's Center for Security and Emerging Technology. Sutskever, who also co-founded OpenAI, was instrumental in the ousting of Altman, according to reports.

It can be speculated that the RBI had some worrying leading indicators which could have triggered this measure, the report said.--IANS

Retail investor exuberance pushing up broader market

New Delhi, Nov 20 (IANS) Retail investor exuberance is pushing up the broader market. Investors should not be blinded by the recency bias and chase small caps running away without fundamental support, says V.K. Vijayakumar, Chief Investment Strategist at Geojit Financial Services.

In spite of recent underperformance, safety is now in large caps. Since FII's turned buyers in the cash market on two days recently, they are unlikely to sell big and may again buy on favourable developments, he said.

There is momentum in large-cap IT stocks. The expectation that US will not tip into a sharp recession has improved the prospects for IT. Autos, telecom, capital goods and construction-related segments are likely to remain resilient. Banking stocks bouncing back is only a matter of time, he said.

"The ongoing rally in the mother market US triggered by declining bond yields makes the market construct slightly favourable for the continuation of the rally in India," he added.

\$173 mn lost in crypto so far in November: Report

New Delhi, Nov 20 (IANS) The month of November has witnessed a loss of \$173 million in cryptocurrency so far, with two incidents making up 91 per cent of the losses.

According to the blockchain and smart contract security company CertiK, November has already registered the fourth-highest monthly losses in 2023. This surge was driven by the recent hack of the cryptocurrency exchange Poloniex. Hackers have stolen over \$114 million from Poloniex after its "hot wallets" were drained by cyber-criminals.

Arkham data showed that an Ethereum wallet, now tagged as "Poloniex hacker," sent a total of \$114 million worth of tokens from Poloniex in 357 transactions. "Losses in November had so far reached \$173 million with two incidents making up 91 per cent of the losses," CertiK Alert posted on X. "November already has the 4th highest losses of any month this year," it added. The security firm also reported that one particular phishing scheme resulted in a loss of around \$27 million.

On the other hand, the confirmed losses from hacks, frauds, and exploits in October were substantially smaller, at around \$32.2 million. Meanwhile, over \$7 billion in cryptocurrency has been illicitly laundered through cross-chain crime, with North Korea's Lazarus Group being linked to the theft of around \$900 million between July 2022 and July of this year. According to the blockchain analytics firm Elliptic, decentralised exchanges (DEXs), cross-chain bridges and coin swap services have processed \$7 billion of illicit funds.

OpenAI board must tell why they sacked Sam, says a 'worried' Musk

New Delhi, Nov 20 (IANS) Elon Musk on Monday said that it is very important for the public to know why OpenAI's board felt so strongly to sack Sam Altman as CEO before it aims to reinstate him after heavy backlash.

The X owner and earlier OpenAI investor said that he is very worried about the developments at the ChatGPT company as it is a matter of AI safety.

"Very important for the public to know why the board felt so strongly about their actions. If it was a matter of AI safety, that would affect all of Earth," Musk posted on X. "OpenAI is not publicly traded and all the money in the world won't matter if AI goes wrong," he added. Defending OpenAI's Co-founder and chief scientist Ilya Sutskever, who reportedly was instrumental in the ousting of Altman, Musk said that he Sutskever a good "moral compass" and does not seek power. "He would not take such drastic action unless he felt it was absolutely necessary," the billionaire posted.
